## "Springing Into Action"

A couple of days ago as I walked one of our dogs, the warm air and the smell of Spring finally hit me. I am so thankful that Spring has truly finally sprung. Over the last couple of weeks we had our Easter celebration and Annual Gospel Workshop.

### God's wonderful actions:

1. ***A church member participating in the Gospel Workshop prayed for a woman*** - She came to me (Paul) and introduced a lady whom she had just met (singing together). We talked some about who we are and then when asked if she could be prayed for she said yes. She hasn't made a decision yet but please pray that she would. She would like to come to the Ladies' Bible study.
2. ***One of the instructors made a decision to follow Christ*** - Over the last 7 years a relationship has been formed with this instructor. He finally understood that nothing was in the way of him making this decision. He is now attending our Men's Bible study.
3. ***Spiritual matters discussed with another participant*** - One of our teammates was able to talk with a woman right before the concert about spiritual matters. She still holds though to the understanding that she has "to do" in order to have a right standing before God. Pray for her.
4. ***A Dentist friend is not ready yet but is really close*** - A relationship has been built with a dentist who was at an English camp, the Gospel Workshop and Easter morning worship service.
