1. The H.S. is the author (2 Pt. 1:21 + 2 Ti. 3:16): Inspiration is the process by which Spirit-moved writers recorded God-breathed writings!

2. **He** (the HS) has given us the Outline of the Revelation (Rev. 1:19)
This threefold division is the key to the entire structure of the book:
 - A. "What you have seen" would be the inaugural vision of chap. 1
 - B. "What is now" ... the letters to the seven churches of chaps. 2-3
 - C. "What will take place after these things" ... chaps. 4-22

NIV Study Bible Note on 4:1-5:14 ...

THE IMMEDIATE CONTEXT: Revelation 5:9, 10

This would be chaps. 4 & 5. "These two chapters constitute an introduction to chaps. 6-20. In the throne room of heaven, the Lamb assumes the responsibility of initiating the great final conflict with the forces of evil, the end of which will see the Lamb triumphant and the devil consigned to the lake of fire." The NIV Study Bible Note on 4:1-5:14.
