## INTRODUCTION:

The word "appears" & "appeared" show up in our text four times. The 1<sup>st</sup> two occurrences speak of His second coming/appearing; the 2<sup>nd</sup> two occurrences speak of His first coming. Unholy conduct or ungodly living is unthinkable in the Christian who has grasped the purpose of the two appearances of Christ. The fact of His 1<sup>st</sup> coming and the hope of His 2<sup>nd</sup> are both strong incentives to personal holiness.

## WHEN HE SHALL APPEAR (2:28-3:3)

In view of the certain appearing/coming of Jesus Christ, John gave three incentives that motivated him (and the same should motivate us) to Christ-like purity ... the pursuit of holiness.

## WHAT CHRIST CAME TO DO (3:4-10)

Christ came to break the power of sin; thus sin is incompatible with abiding in Him. Those who act righteously are living in Christ, but those who are unrighteous are of the Devil. The presence of absence of righteous behavior is a clear distinction between the children of God and the children of the Devil.
