## INTRODUCTION:

- 1. Context: Between 2:3-11 and 2:18-27
- 2. Interpretation: "dear children, fathers, young men"
  - A. Three **DEVELOPMENTAL** categories.
  - B. <u>ALL</u> his readers from different <u>ANGLES</u>.

CONFLICT WITH THE <u>EVIL</u> ONE (2:12-14)

- 1. I write to you: **DEAR CHILDREN** (vss. 12; 13c) The earliest conscious experiences of newborn Christians:
  - A. "because your sins have been forgiven (verb: PT)"

"on account of his name" (cp. Ephesians 2:7)

- B. "because you have known (verb: PT) the father."
- 2. I write to you: FATHERS (vss. 13a; 14a)

The fathers are the spiritually mature in the congregation. They have progressed into a deep communion with God. Both times he addresses them, John uses identical words: "you've known him who is from the beginning."

- 3. I write to you: YOUNG MEN (vss. 13b; 14b)
  - A. "you have overcome (NEB "mastered") the evil one" (2x).
  - B. "you are strong, and the word of God lives in you." This is the secret of the young men's victory over the evil one.

PERSONAL CHALLENGE

- 1. God has already made <u>**PROVISION**</u> for you to grow.
- 2. It is every believer's **<u>RESPONSIBILITY</u>** to grow.

- 2. The Rationale (vs. 15b-17)

    "Love of the world squeezes out love for the Father." [The Message] The real location of worldliness is internal, residing in our hearts (16)
    - 1) "The cravings of sinful man" (lit. "the flesh"; James 4:1-6a)
    - 2) "The lust of his eyes"
    - 3) "The boasting of what he has and does"
  - B. Because of \_\_\_\_\_\_ the world is \_\_\_\_\_. There's no future in worldliness. None! This world is temporary, superficial, it does not satisfy. It results in unadvertised consequences.
- 3. The Challenge (facing Christians and the Church today)
  - A. Resisting worldliness requires strenuous effort. It's an inside battle & hard heart-work is needed. And it's a lifelong battle.
  - B. The antidote to worldliness is the cross of Christ. Only thru the power of the cross can we successfully resist the seduction of a fallen world. See Galatians 6:14; 5:16, 24.
  - C. We must fight worldliness because it dulls our affections for Christ and distracts our attention from Christ.
