<u>Missionary of the Month:</u> Jeff and Meredith (World Venture - Albania)

Our ministry vision is to see the Gospel *flourish* and *take root* among the people we serve. We are working at being engaged in two distinct, but related ministries: 1) discipleship and evangelism in and through our local church, and 2) holistic discipleship in the marketplace through a Christian non-profit.

As it relates to the first ministry, we've been very involved in our local church where Jeff is a preaching elder and I take an active role in outreach ministries to children and teaching ESL. Much of our ministry involves living life shoulder to shoulder with the members of our church. This was a particularly powerful component of our ministry in the past year or so after we experienced a devastating earthquake as well as a tight military lockdown related to the pandemic. Our church's outreach quickly transitioned to providing food and necessities to families both within our church but also in our community. As a church body, we have been able to start building meaningful relationships with several of these families receiving food and are praying that the seeds of the Gospel that we have been planting and watering in their lives will ultimately bear fruit. Walking closely with the members of our church through a hard year greatly deepened our relationship with them and their trust in us. More importantly, we all grew in trust and dependency in the Lord!

As it relates to our second ministry, Jeff has spearheaded the expansion of developing relationships with professionals in the marketplace who would not normally darken the doors of the local church. Because of Jeff's prior professional experience as a business lawyer, he's able to develop relationships with businessmen and lawyers that most missionaries and pastors wouldn't be able to. Through these relationships, the Gospel is shared.

Praise God for the new relationships our church is forming in our community. Please pray that these individuals would accept Christ.
Praise God for new opportunities available to Jeff among Christians who desire to start Kingdom focused business for God's glory. Pray that they can come alongside these brothers and sisters with knowhow and resources and with gospel encouragement.
