DANIEL'S SEVENTIETH WEEK (24:4-28)

These 25 verses (4-28) detail the events of Daniel's 70th week. Ver. 29 gives us the chronology. Jesus said, "Immediately after the distress of those days."

- 1. Nine signs of Jesus' Second Advent (vss. 4-14)
 - A. First group of five signs (vss. 4-8)
 False Christs; wars & intn'l. unrest; famine; pestilence; earthquakes.
 Verse 8 "All these are the beginning of birth pains."
 - B. Second group of four signs (vss. 9-14)
 Persecution of believers in Jesus Christ; false prophets; lawlessness;
 the Gospel of the Kingdom preached "in the whole world".
- 2. The "abomination that causes desolation" (24:15-20)
 - A. Satan's war in heaven and on earth (Rev. 12-13) War in heaven (12:7-13) and War on Earth (13:1-18)
 - B. Antichrist's abominable act (vs. 15)
 - C. Admonitions from Jesus (vss. 16-20)

- D. Great Tribulation Jewish Remnant (Rev. 12:6; Zech 13:7-9)
- The Great Tribulation (24:21-28) The last half of Daniel's 70th week (42 months; 1,260 days).

- Parable of the _____ (24:45-51)
 This parable contrasts those who are properly prepared for the Second Coming of the Lord Jesus Christ with those who are not prepared, nor in a right standing with the Lord.
- Parable of the ______ virgins (25:1-13) In the context of a Jewish wedding, the virgins were bridesmaids, attendants to the bride. <u>Watching</u> and <u>preparing</u> for His coming are two keys to this parable.

WORKING UNTIL FOR THE KING'S ARRIVAL (25:14-30)

Working & performing is the key to the parable of the talents. While we wait for the King, we must work and produce for Him in His absence.
