Faith Promise Giving

FAITH PROMISE giving is the amount promised by individuals in a local church to be given to the missionary program, over and above regular giving.

CHRIST'S commands (Mark 16:15), in which He encourages faith, commitment, prayer and giving (2 Cor. 5, Ps. 76:11, Luke 6:38).

ADVANTAGES:

- Parents may teach children the importance and blessing of giving.
- It also helps create a favorable atmosphere to yielding to Christ's service.
- Believers are also spiritually strengthened as they seek God's guidance and provision in this matter.

FAITH PROMISE is different than a pledge (which is binding between an individual and the church). Faith promise is just between an individual and the Lord. There is never any billing, nor information made public.

SIGNING a card enables the treasurer to calculate the total promised by the church to determine the Mission budget for the year. The cards are then destroyed.

EXPERIENCE has proven this program does not take away from regular church giving.
