- 2. The Kingdom Corrupted (Gen. 3)

- in the moment Adam sinned & joined Satan's rebellion against the Creator, God lost His human rep. to rule over the realm of earth.
- without a rep. to rule over & administer the realm of earth, God's will would no longer be done on Earth as it is in Heaven.

3. The Kingdom Ruler (the first promise - Gen. 3:15)
- Jesus Christ became the fulfillment of God's promise to send a male child to restore His kingdom & rule on Earth.
- fr. Adam thru Seth to Noch thru Shem to Abroham thru Tassa

- fr. Adam thru Seth to Noah thru Shem to Abraham thru Isaac, thru Jacob, thru Judah and his descendants to David.

- The remainder of vss. 6-7 will be fulfilled at the Lord's 2<sup>nd</sup> Advent. 2.
