



Defying Jihad By Esther Amed


I daresay, once you commence reading this fascinating memoir of a young Pakistani Muslim lady, you will not be able to put it down. Her journey to faith in Christ is nothing short of miraculous.

Zakriah (aka Esther) who was born into a wealthy, militant Muslim family, became a devoted follower of Allah. In her early twenties, she decided to make the ultimate sacrifice by volunteering for jihad. "The more infidels (Jews and Christians) you kill, the greater your reward in heaven will be" her religious leader informed her. A short time before she was scheduled to leave for training, God intervened! This began the quest to know the true God.

As a new believer, she was devoted to serving Christ and was zealous in her witness for Him. This resulted in constant threats on her life. Her own father resolved to end her life. How she escaped from her father's clutches will keep you spellbound.

God led her to a godly man whom she married. Because her father was in constant search for her, they fled to Malaysia. While living there, they lived in extreme poverty. Often, they didn't know where their next meal was coming from but they learned they could always depend on God to provide. For the rest of the story, read Defying Jihad.

#### 3:16 THE NUMBERS OF HOPE By Max Lucado

3:16 - The Numbers of Hope, is popular author Max Lucado's exposition of the famously familiar verse in the Bible, John 3:16.

Although Christians have probably read or heard this verse hundreds of times, Lucado does a masterful job of breaking it down word by word

to help us fathom the rich theology that can be easily glossed over. He develops in detail words like God, world, loved, only Son, gave, believes, perish, eternal, among others. Lucado's engaging literary style makes this an enjoyable read while also developing the deep, almost mind-boggling meaning of this verse of hope. The last part of the book consists of a forty-day devotional centered on Jesus' earthly life.

While this book is very inspirational for Christians, I feel it would make a great gift for an unbeliever who is considering becoming a Christian and who would here find a great explanation of God's love for mankind, as demonstrated through the sacrifice of His Son Jesus Christ, and written in a very understandable way.

# Sam Rotman Concert Sunday, October 24; 6 PM

When Sam Rotman made his debut at the age of 16 with the San Antonio Symphony Orchestra before an audience of 6,000 people, the Baldwin Keynote Magazine wrote, "Sam Rotman is a pianist with abundant potential."

Mr. Rotman received his Bachelor and Master of Music degrees from the Juilliard School in New

York City. While a student, he was the recipient of nine awards in the form of grants, scholarships, and prizes. Today Mr. Rotman is a member of The Augustus D. Juilliard Society at the Juilliard School. Subsequently, he has been among the winners in five piano competitions, both in the United States and Europe.

The most prestigious award was that of Laureate Winner in the 4th International Beethoven Competition in Vienna, Austria. Mr. Rotman participated in the 6th International Tchaikovsky Piano Competition in Moscow, Russia. In May 2016, he was awarded an Honorary Doctor of Fine Arts Degree from The Master's University where Dr. John MacArthur is President. Mr. Rotman is the only recipient of such an Honorary Doctorate in the school's history. He was also nominated for the Pennsylvania Governor's Award for Excellence in the Arts. Mr. Rotman has given over 3100 performances in the United States, Canada, Mexico, the Caribbean, South and Central America, Africa, South Africa, Europe and Asia, totaling 61 countries.

Mr. Rotman has devoted a specific area of his musical life to the study and performance of the works of Beethoven. Beginning with a series of all Beethoven concerts in 1970 (the Beethoven bi-centennial), he was presented on Public Broadcast System in a special Beethoven concert. Mr. Rotman continues to perform the works of Beethoven in recital and with orchestra.
