

"The World That Perished" by John Whitcom

This book is a condensed, popular version of material in *The Genesis Flood* by Dr. John Whitcom and Dr. Henry Morris and is about 150 pages long. *The Genesis Flood* is a longer book of over 500 pages and records Dr. Morris explaining how the geologic record is best explained by a global flood. Dr. Whitcom then shows that the flood account in Genesis describes a fairly recent global flood. *The World That Perished* is a

much shorter book that mostly deals with the biblical account of the flood as found in

Genesis. He mentions Dr. Morris's findings but is not technical.

His main point is the Genesis account is best understood as literal history, not allegory, poetry, etc. A related point is that the English translation is accurate, and it is a mistake to insert a gap or interpret the words for "day" as an age.

Dr. Whitcom has a doctorate from Princeton in ancient Semetic languages and taught Hebrew at Grace Seminary. He is well qualified to evaluate the English translation of Genesis. Dr. Henry Morris has a doctorate in Hydrology, worked for the US Geologic Survey, and taught the subject at Virginia Tech. He is also qualified to evaluate the geologic record.

This material is a major influence in starting the current Young Earth movement and influenced me by showing that C.I. Scofield's Gap theory is incorrect. *The World That Perished* is a good introduction to the subject. (reviewed by Bruce Flora)
