The Bible uses one metaphor more frequently than any other to denote our relationship to the divine Master: δοῦλος (doulos). It

means 1) a "slave" who completely belongs to his owner and has no freedom to leave; and 2) a "servant" who willingly chooses to serve his master.

4. Through hardship and temptation, we are to be loyal (faithful) to Jesus Christ.

- 1. Paul again was a prisoner in Rome! See 1:8; 1:16; 2:9; 1:17 (in Rome).
- 2. His situation was not the same as the one in Acts 28 (A.D. 59-61).

3.	His epistle belongs to the time following Nero's edict making Christianity <i>religio illicita</i> (an illegal religion). The edict was issued in the Fall of A.D. 64 after a horrendous fire destroyed almost three quarters of Rome in July of A.D. 64.	
4.	Was Paul's situation unique? Was he experiencing something unusual or out of the ordinary?
