### **INTRODUCTION:**

- Christmas is a unique opportunity for evangelism.
- 2. **Fear** hinders evangelism more than any other single factor.



- 3. In our text for this morning, 2 Tim. 1:8-18, the word "ashamed" appears four times.
- 4. Four action steps to overcome fear in evangelism.

## **Appropriate**

the power of the indwelling Holy Spirit (vss. 6-8)

1. Every Christian is <u>indwelt</u> by the Holy Spirit.

Does "spirit" (vs. 7) refer to the human spirit, or are we to take "spirit" as referring to the Holy Spirit?

## 2 TIMOTHY 1:6-7

"For this reason I remind you to keep alive the gift that God gave you when I laid my hands on you. For the Spirit that God has given us does not make us timid; instead, his Spirit fills us with power, love, and self-control."

## 2 CORINTHIANS 5:18-21

2 CORINTHIANS

"God has reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation. . . . And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation. We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us. We implore you on Christ's behalf: Be reconciled to God. God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God."

### Reaffirm

Your confidence in God's ability to protect you.

- 1. "I know whom I have believed" (12).
- 2. "I am convinced He is able to guard what I have entrusted to him for that day" (12).
  - A. His **soul**, or his eternal destiny.
  - B. His **physical** circumstances/life/safety.
  - C. His ministry (cp. 1 Cor. 4:1-5).

- 1. Pray for Open Doors (Col. 4:3)
  - A. **Spontaneous** ones
  - B. **Planned** ones
- 2. Pray for Open Mouths (Eph. 6:19-20)
