

My Wynter Season: Seeing God's Faithfulness in the Shadow of Grief By Jonathan Pitts

One of my goals this past year, and the year coming, is to read books written by people with diverse backgrounds (African Americans, Europeans, Asian, Women, Men, etc.)

so I was very excited to see this book written by a black ministry director and pastor. Little did I know how much this book would open my eyes to God's faithfulness both in life and in death.

Jonathan Pitts, an executive director at Urban Alternative (the ministry of Dr. Tony Evans) was living the perfect life. He had a loving wife, four amazing kids, and an incredible boss. But that was before tragedy hit. His wife of 15 years, Wynter, unexpectedly died at the age of 38. His life was turned upside down. He was not used to being alone in life and had now lost his best friend and companion.

Pitts chose not to be bitter, but to see the way God was with him in the season of death. He tells of a certain article published the day Wynter died that encouraged him. He tells how relationships both he and his wife had cultivated were such a blessing to him and his young family after the loss of his most important earthly relationship. Most of all, he tells the story of how he realized God was his best friend and constant companion. Even though death might not yet be a part of the story of your life, I can guarantee trials and tragedy have impacted you.

My Wynter Season showed me that God's faithfulness isn't only apparent in the big miracles and big circumstances, but also in the mundane. His faithfulness is in the family picture that was taken just before Wynter's death. It is in the strong relationships that God placed in their lives. It is in the wall decor in Pitts' bedroom that says "Be Still." This book helped me see the mundane ways in my life where I can truly sing "How Great Thou Art!" (reviewed by Grace Anderson)
