3. THE _____ (21:1-25)

Chapter 21 is separated from the main body by 20:30-31. I some respects ch. 21 seems to be an afterthought, but it is not. It is an integral follow-up to the main narrative. The purpose of the Epilogue is to show how the belief which the disciples had <u>achieved</u> should be <u>applied</u>. [The word "believe" is not used in ch. 21]. The last chapter of the Gospel opens the door to the future & shows how belief should be translated into terms of daily activity.
