







- 1. The birth of a baby is a common event in our world.
- 2. There was only one **UNIQUE** birth in human history.
- 3. Note the three great contrasts between vers. 1 & 14:
  - A. Verse 1: "in the beginning was the Word" Verse 14: "the Word became flesh"
  - B. Verse 1: "was with God"

    Verse 14: "made his dwelling among us"
    - C. Verse 1: "the Word was God"

      Verse 14: "became flesh"

"In the moment Adam sinned and joined Satan's rebellion against the Creator, God lost His human representative to rule over the real of Earth. Jesus is the "last Adam" (1 Cor. 15:45). When our Lord returns He will take the reins of government and rule the nations of this world as a benevolent dictator (Rev. 19:15). He will show Himself to be "King of kings & Lord of lords" in the same arena where man's rebellion against God took place (Gen. 3:1ff.). God's purpose in restoring His Kingdom on Earth is to demonstrate to all of His creation that He alone is the One true God of the universe."
