



THE CASE FOR HEAVEN

by Lee Strobel

I recently read "The Case for Heaven" by Lee Strobel. You should read it. Really, you need to read it! Whether you believe in the reality of a place called Heaven or even if you are skeptical or doubtful, you will be challenged and encouraged by this book. I

was! We all owe ourselves a serious inquiry about the reality of Heaven and how we can get there.

Strobel writes this book in the style of his other books as a thorough investigative journalist, interviewing Christian scholars about major questions, doubts, objections, and ideas about death and dying, the afterlife, and Heaven.

When I attend a conference or read a book, I often find one session or chapter, and say "this alone is worth the price." That chapter in this book is the last one, titled "On The Edge of Eternity," where Strobel flies to Portland, Oregon and interviews evangelist Luis Palau, just before Palau died of Stage IV lung cancer last year. Palau's excitement about getting ready to move to Heaven is super-encouraging. And don't skip over the 7-page conclusion either! Living with Parkinson's and having seen a number of friends and loved ones enter there lately makes me think more and more about Heaven. I don't want anyone to miss it! (reviewed by Steve Swope)
