


2022-2023 OLYMPIANS CURRICULUM MODULES

The Olympians Bible Study is a module-style curriculum designed to help children establish a biblical foundation that will encourage obedience to God's Word out of a love for Jesus Christ. Each module consists of creatively developed lessons that enable a teacher to present biblical truth in a practical way with a variety of styles.



THE BIBLE: ONE STORY

Jesus: Hero of the World

Children will learn that the Bible is one complete story that all points to the main Character – Jesus Christ – and will be encouraged to trust Jesus as their Savior.

Jesus: Healer of the World

Children will learn how Jesus had a passion for compassion and will be challenged to become more like Jesus by showing compassion to others.

Jesus: Redeemer of the World

Children will learn that Jesus Christ came to redeem mankind from sin and will be encouraged to trust in Jesus as the only way to have a relationship with God.

Jesus: Savior of the World

Children will learn that a relationship with God is only made possible through believing in the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus Christ, God's Son – and will be encouraged to trust Jesus Christ as Savior.

OLD TESTAMENT BOOK STUDY – PROVERBS

True Treasure Hunting

Children will learn the meaning of godly wisdom and will be challenged to follow God's wisdom each day.

Ant Wisdom

Children will learn the wisdom of being diligent and be challenged to not be lazy, but to work hard – even when no one is looking.

Who Do You Hang With?

Children will discover the wise treasure of carefully choosing friends and will be challenged to find and become the right kind of friend.

Words to Treasure

Children will learn the importance of the words they say and how they say them and be encouraged to choose gentleness in their speech that others will treasure.

NEW TESTAMENT BOOK STUDY – 1 JOHN

The Light of God vs. The Darkness of Sin

Children will learn the difference between walking in light (with God) and walking in darkness (in sin) and will be encouraged to remain in fellowship with God by walking in the light of obedience to Him.

The Jesus Path vs. The Wicked Way


Children will learn that Jesus Christ is the perfect example of obedience to God and will be encouraged to obey God to the best of their ability.

Loving God vs. Loving the World

Children will learn the importance of loving what God loves and will be encouraged to make choices that demonstrate their love for God.

Children will learn that God loves them so much that He sent His only Son to die in their place, and will be challenged to show sacrificial love toward others.

Children will learn about the great power of God and will be encouraged to have faith in Him and be brave when faced with difficult circumstances.

God Will Fight for Us

Children will learn that God's will is always best and will be encouraged to not be afraid because God is the One fighting for them.

Children will learn that our possessions are given by God and will be encouraged to use what they have to meet the needs of others.

Give with Open Hands

Children will learn that generosity comes from loving the Lord and will be encouraged to start being generous with what they have.

BUILDING CHARACTER: BIBLICAL EXAMPLES

Is It Time Yet?

Children will learn to trust in God's timing and will be encouraged to take positive actions as they wait for God to fulfill His promises.

What's Missing?

Children will learn that God's way is always the best way and will be challenged to obey Him with every aspect of their lives.

How May I Help?

Children will learn about the importance of serving God with their gifts and talents and will be encouraged to always be looking for ways to serve Him.

What Can Man Do to Me?

Children will learn that faithfulness to God can be difficult and bring persecution, but they will be encouraged to remain faithful to God despite mistreatment.

John Newton: Transformed by God's Amazing Grace

Children will learn that even the worst of sinners is within the reach of God's amazing grace, and they will be challenged to let the power of the Gospel transform their lives.

George Mueller: A Prayer Powerhouse

Children will learn that God answers the prayers of His people and will be encouraged to go to Him with their requests, no matter how big or small.

Children will learn that God desires for them to serve others selflessly, and they will be challenged to find someone they can serve generously for the glory of God.

Who Do You Care For?



Children will learn the importance of caring for everyone and will be encouraged to do good to one another every day.

Children will learn that God expects them to love all people, including their enemies – no matter how they feel – and will be encouraged to show that love to others in practical ways.

Abounding Thankfulness

Children will learn of the infinite value of God's love and faithfulness and will be encouraged to show overflowing thankfulness to Him in response to His wonderful works.

SPIRITUAL GROWTH

Quiet Time is the Best Time

Children will learn the value of having a quiet time with God regularly as opposed to simply doing a quiet time, and will choose to meet with Him out of a growing desire for His direction.

Living a Life of Prayer

Children will learn that prayer draws them closer to God and will be encouraged to spend more time with Him in prayer.

God's Great Workout Plan

Children will learn how discipline allows them to do something well with great confidence and will be encouraged to commit to spiritual growth disciplines as a way to know and love God more.
