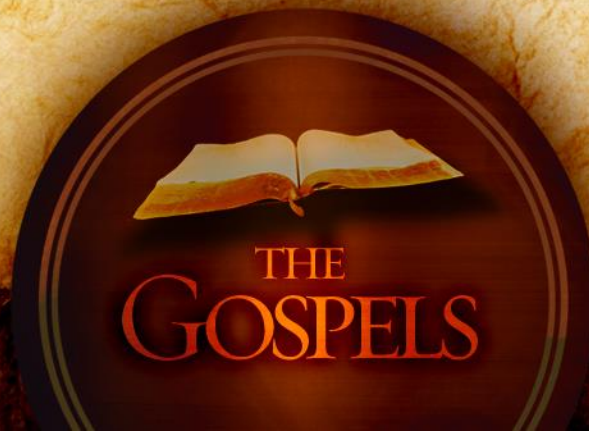

1. Chapter 12 is the turning point in the plot; the transition in the career of Jesus from a public to a private ministry.

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SETTING:

1. Chapter 12 is the turning point in the plot; the transition in the career of Jesus from a public to a private ministry.
2. The unfolding events of chapter 12 include . . .
 - A. His arrives in Bethany. Mary's act of Devotion (1-11)
 - B. His triumphal entry into Jerusalem (12-19).
 - C. Jesus anticipates His death (20-36)
Two factors caused our Lord to focus on His death.
 - 1) The Request of some Greeks (vss.20-22)
 - 2) The Rejection of the Jews (vss.37-41)



HIS DEATH WAS
A TIMELY DEATH (vs.23)

1. Taught throughout the **Gospel** of **John**.
2. Taught throughout the **New Testament**.
3. **God**, dear people, is always **on time**.

HIS DEATH WAS
A NECESSARY DEATH (vs.23)

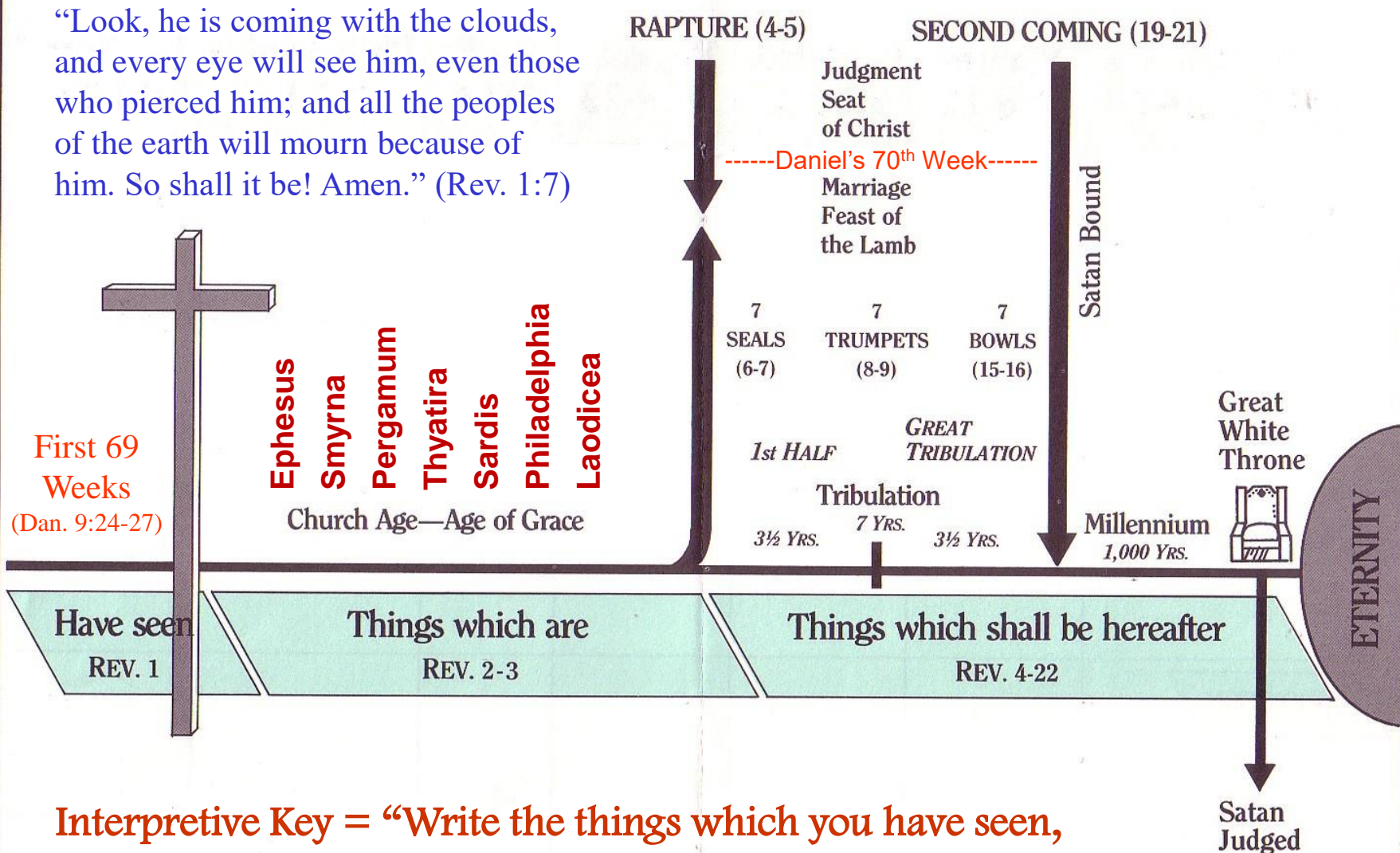
1. For **Jesus** to die
2. For **us** to die



HIS DEATH WAS
A TRIUMPHANT DEATH (vss. 23, 31-33)

1. His exaltation will be realized (vs. 23)
2. His enemies will be destroyed (vs. 31)

“Look, he is coming with the clouds,
and every eye will see him, even those
who pierced him; and all the peoples
of the earth will mourn because of
him. So shall it be! Amen.” (Rev. 1:7)



**Interpretive Key = “Write the things which you have seen,
and the things which are, and the things which will take place
after these things.” (Revelation 1:19)**



HIS DEATH WAS
A TRIUMPHANT DEATH (vss. 23, 31-33)

1. His **exaltation** will be realized (vs. 23)
2. His **enemies** will be destroyed (vs. 31)
3. His **elect** will be gathered (vss. 32, 33)



E. The destruction (Purging/Cleansing) of the Present Heavens & Earth by fire (2 Pet. 3:10-13) and creation of a New Heavens & Earth (Rev. 21:1ff.)

3. His elect will be gathered (vss. 32-33)
