These four epistles were written to instruct believers about life during the last days before the rapture of the church. The study emphasizes being zealous for God's Word, proper Christian behavior and evangelistic concern, and the rejection of false and destructive teachers. Through studying these epistles, you (we) will understand the need for discernment of truth and of a practice of distinctive Christian living during these troubled-filled last days.
