- 1. The events of John 6 took place over a period of two days, and the chapter is divided into two parts (one part for each day).
- 2. Jesus' teaching on the bread of life divides into three parts corresponding to the three types of hearers in the audience.
- 3. What I really want you to note is the POPULARITY of Jesus at the beginning of chap. 6. But as the chapter unfolds, we observe a drastic change came over these so called "followers".

The longest chapter in John's gospel begins with **5000** (6:10) & ends with **ELEVEN** (6:70-71). "Jesus lost the crowd of 'seekers' with one sermon" [Wiersbe].

4. What Happened? ANSWER: Jesus spoke the Truth! The discourse on "the bread of life" is a dialogue between Christ and the people especially the religious leaders ("the Jews"). As Jesus spoke truth to the culture of His day (1st cent. Judaism; A.D. 26-30), we observe *four responses* to the Lord's teaching.

	SUS "HIS DISCIPLES" (6:64-71) ree attitudes that parallel responses we see today:
1.	Open (64-66) "From this time many of his disciples turned back & no longer followed him."
2.	Firm (67-69) "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. We believe and know that you are the Holy One of God."
3.	Subtle (70-71) "Have I not chosen you, the Twelve? Yet one of you is a devil."
	AKING IT PERSONAL: eological Observations from John 6
1.	John 6 reminds us of the human apart from Christ (vss. 44, 63, 65): Dead, Blind, Sinful, Bad, and Helpless.
2.	John 6 reminds us of what god is doing in the world (vss. 39-40): Jesus is building His Church.
3.	John 6 reminds us of the Church's As Jesus spoke truth to His culture (1 st century Judaism), so we are to speak truth in our day to ours.
