Philemon, Titus, and 2 Timothy focus upon *forgiveness*, *righteousness* & *faithfulness*. We enter upon the Christian life as God grants us forgiveness in Jesus Christ. As we grow in Christ, our lives become increasingly characterized by righteousness. And God expects faithfulness from us, His servants, until He takes us home to heaven.

Godliness – A key word (along with “godly”) in the Pastorals, occurring eight times in 1 Timothy (2:2; 3:16; 4:7-8; 6:3, 5-6, 11), once in 2 Timothy (3:5) and once in Titus (1:1), but nowhere else in the writings of Paul. It implies a good and holy life, with special emphasis on its source, a deep reverence for God.
