*John 12, Mark 11,
Luke 19, Matt. 21*



Introduction

- Jesus has nearly completed His earthly journey
- He is offering Himself as the promised Messiah to the nation of Israel
- This was an event prophesied by the Old Testament

Arrival in Bethany

John 11:55 to 12:1, 9-11

- Saturday
- Jesus arrives from Jericho
- He sends two disciples to Bethphage - Mark 11:2
- They retrieve the unbroken colt
- Jesus is anointed at Simon the lepers house - John 12:1-8



Bethany

- Sunday
- A large crowd gathers to see Jesus
- John 12:9-11



Triumphal Entry

- Monday
- Jesus mounts the colt with the disciples' cloaks on it - John 12: 12-19
- He fulfills prophecy and offers Himself as the Pascal lamb



Triumphal Entry

- Daniels Prophecy of 70 weeks - Daniel 9:24-27
- 69 weeks of prophetic years of 360 days $(69 \times 7 \times 360) = 173,880$ days
- Decree in 444B.C. Plus 476 solar years = Nisan 10, 33A.D. Or March 30, 33A.D.



Triumphal Entry

- Over 2.56 million people there
- 256,500 lambs sacrificed that year (10 people per lamb = 2.56 million) others were there but unable to sacrifice due to being unclean



Triumphal Entry

- Hosanna! Ps 118:25,26
- The rulers had to kill Jesus!
- This was the day they chose their lamb
- He came on a beast of peace



Conclusion

- Jesus was the fulfillment of God's promise to save the children of God
- God's prophecy is accurate
- God is willing to prove who He is
- He died for you!
