What is discipleship?

Is a process in which a **spiritually mature** and **trained leader** invests into the lives of others with the intention of teaching the Gospel, God's word.

It is an **international relationship** invested authentically and transparently with another to grow into mature and fully equipped follower of Jesus, who are committed to doing the same in the live of others

What is a DISCIPLE?



Disciples are learners who chose to follow Christ's way of love and to live in His love.

Disciples PRAY

- “Alongsiders are CONVINCED that prayer advances the Great Commission.
- Focus remains on God’s agenda (not ours)
- Disciples understand that prayer connects us to the power of the Holy Spirit to do ministry.
- Prayer was the hallmark of the ministry and life of Christ, and it needs to be ours as well!!

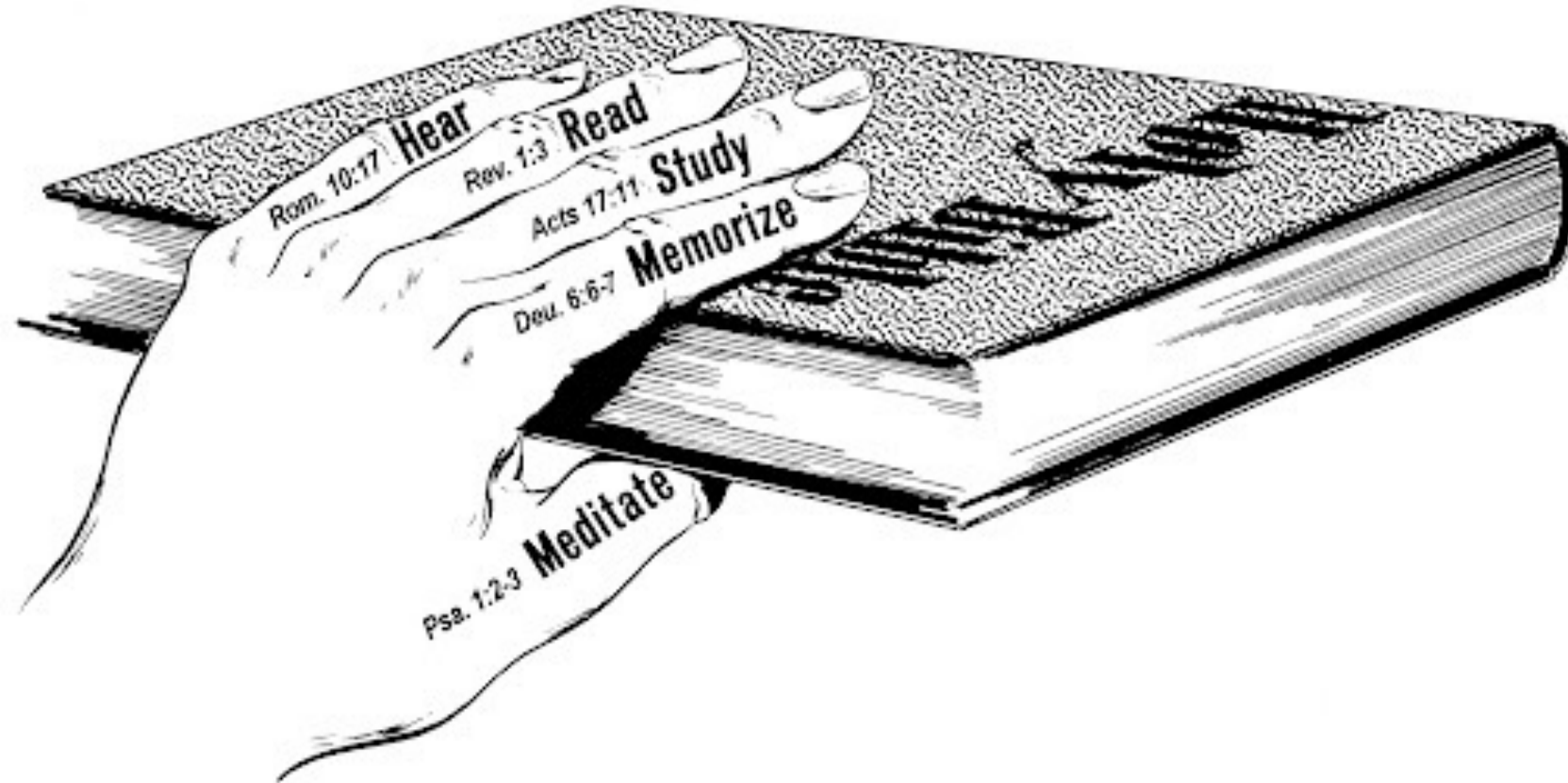

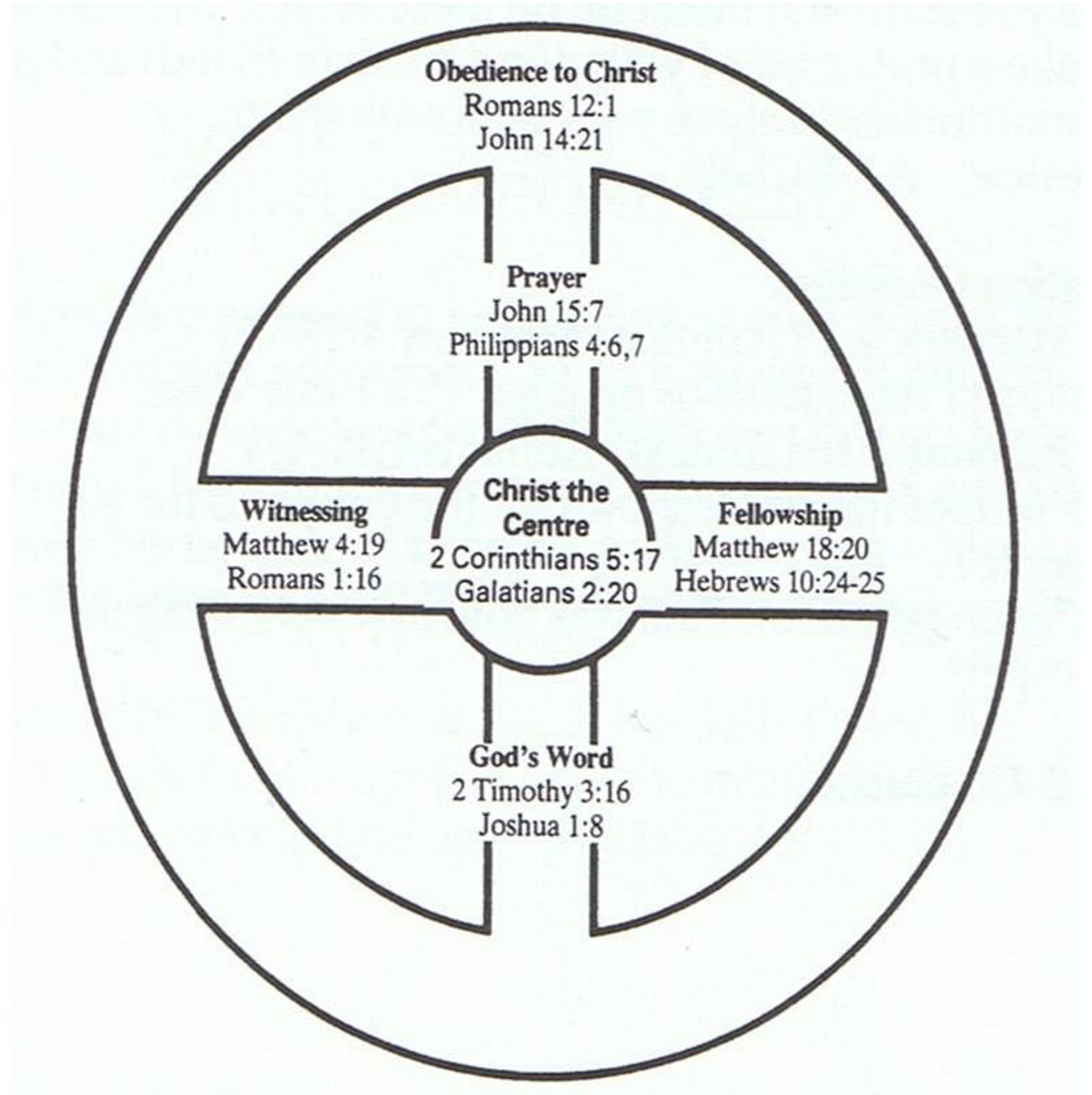

Authenticity

- Marked by love, transparency, vulnerability,
- Trusting the Holy Spirit
- Willingness to expose personal struggles, fears, and life issues inside the safety of a friendship.
- Go deeper by investing in the lives of others
- **LISTEN**: and practice the five levels of communication: Cliché', Information, Judgments/values, feelings, peak
- **GENUINELY LOVE by CARING**: choosing to be concerned, asking questions, remembering concerns and blessings and engaging in practical action.

Follow the teaching model of Christ:

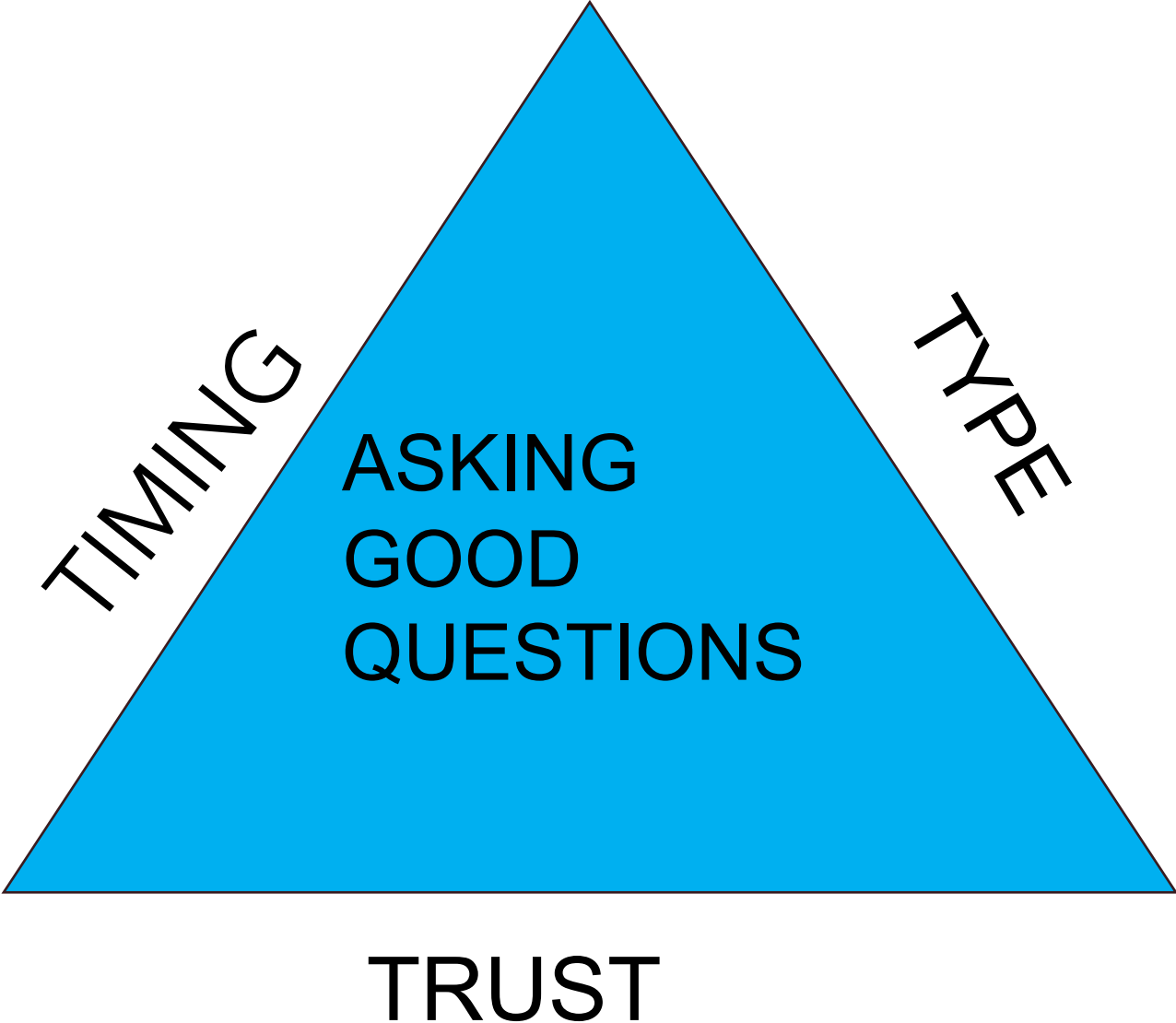
- **Sermon**
