

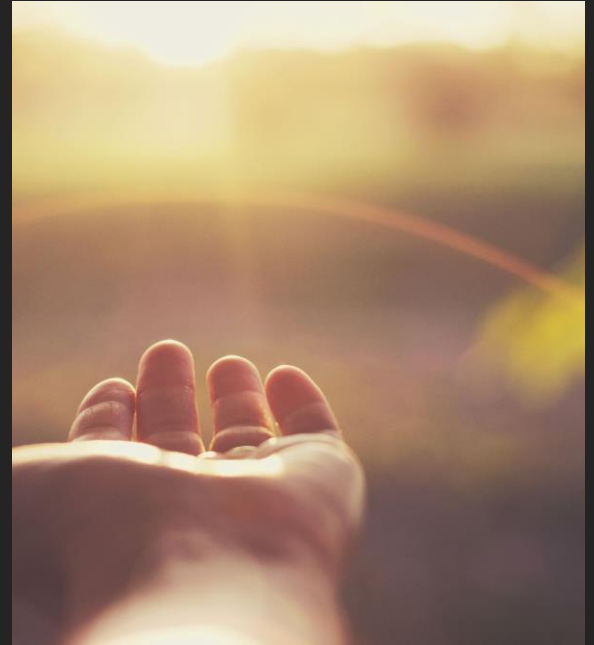

Gal. 6:11-18

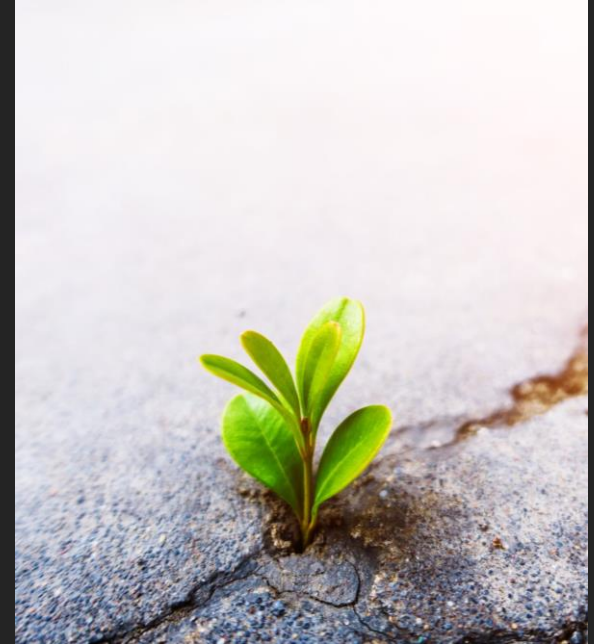
Introduction
