cov*d effect: it wasn't your imagination...

- polarization, migration
- pastoral stress/pain
- only 39% of churches reacted in unified way
- wounds still not healed





Gospel-Centered Conduct (1:27a)

- live in a way that reflects the worth of the gospel
- live as <u>citizens of heaven</u>
- call to <u>integrity</u> and <u>consistency</u>



Unity and Collective Striving (1:27b)

- implied are church <u>unity</u> issues (cf 4:1)
- individually: <u>stand firm</u> in one spirit
- collectively: <u>strive together</u> (lit. alongside)
- active unity, not passive



Courage with opposition (1:28-30)

- suffering: a gift from God?
- suffering: a **positive sign** for us?
- encouragement to <u>resilience</u> from a fellow sufferer



Unity in the faith (2:1-2)

- "if...": rhetorical <u>consider</u> if these qualities <u>exist</u> in your life
- foundations for unity: <u>love</u>, <u>fellowship</u>, <u>compassion</u>
- unity of <u>purpose</u>; agreeableness despite differences
- <u>practical</u> and <u>relational</u>, shaping how we are to interact



Unity through humility (2:3-4)

- humility: antidote to <u>division</u>
- serving: antidote to <u>egos</u> and <u>kingdom</u>
 building
- radical reorientation: from <u>self-focus</u> to <u>community care</u>

- Is something or someone bothering me that shouldn't?
- How well do I model an agreeable spirit? How might others view me?
- How well do I put the needs of others before mine?
